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KEY OBSERVATIONS

ELITE OFFENSES (>35 yards per game):

- Ohio State: 38.3 ypg (elite) – #1 offense in Big Ten
- Michigan: 35.9 ypg (good) – strong balanced attack
- Penn State: 30.6 ypg (good) – solid offensive base

ELITE DEFENSES (<31 yards allowed per game):

- Michigan: 29.9 ypg allowed (elite) – #1 defense, dominant D
- Ohio State: 31.7 ypg allowed (elite) – elite pass rush + coverage

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMULA:

- Ohio State: 8-0 conf, elite O (38.3 ypg) + elite D (31.7 ypg)

= CHAMPIONSHIP CALIBER – balanced excellence

- Michigan: 7-1 conf, good O (35.9 ypg) + elite D (29.9 ypg)

= PLAYOFF LOCK – defensive dominance

PLAYOFF CONTENDERS:

- Ohio State: 13-2 overall, championship caliber
- Michigan: 12-3 overall, elite defense
- Penn State: 10-5 overall, bubble team

CONFERENCE ASSESSMENT:

Big Ten has elite defenses (Michigan #1, Ohio State #2) but only 2 truly elite offenses.
Defensive conference overall – Ohio State's balanced excellence is standout.

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
