KEY OBSERVATIONS

ELITE OFFENSES (>30 yards per game):

- Oregon: 32.4 ypg (good) – #1 PAC offense, balanced attack

- Washington: 30.6 ypg (good) – solid complementary passing

WEAK DEFENSES (>38 yards allowed per game):

- Arizona St: 39.4 ypg allowed (weak) – defensive struggles

- Utah: 45.2 ypg allowed (poor) – major defensive issues

- Arizona: 47.8 ypg allowed (poor) – worst in conference

CONFERENCE ASSESSMENT:

PAC-12 is weakest power conference overall. Oregon offers only real elite performance. Defensive conference-wide issues with only Oregon below 32 ypg.

PLAYOFF VIABILITY:

- Oregon: 11-4 overall, 7-1 conf – only PAC team with playoff potential

- Washington: 10-5 overall, 6-2 conf – strong secondary team

WEAKNESS SIGNALS:

- No elite defenses in PAC-12 (best is Oregon at 29.9)

- Limited offensive weapons (only Oregon/Washington above 30 ypg)

- Large gap between Oregon (#1) and rest of conference

POSTSEASON REALITY:
Only Oregon likely to qualify for major bowl. Conference-wide talent
disparity creates weak overall reputation nationally.
